WELCOME TO THE CORGI MAY TO AUGUST 2022 RANGE!

Corgi products arrivals and announcements for the sunny summer months of 2022. Following on from our January range launch, we're excited to bring you an even wider range of products as the year continues, including the introduction of an entirely new range of 1:76 scale products designed for model railway layouts that is exclusive to corgi.co.uk.

Among the new products featured, we have to highlight the first of our newly tooled items for 2022 for pre-order in this catalogue. We think the Ford Cortina Mk5 is an excellent addition to the Vanguards range, and have been working to bring you the most accurate version possible of this classic car. In Aviation Archive, our Falklands commemorative range is completed with the addition of two new models, including

the first release of a Sea Harrier FRS.1 model for the first time in over a decade. Likewise in Original Omnibus, trams return to the range after a long absence with a striking livery that was run on Blackpool promenade in the mid-1990s.

We hope you enjoy this preview of what is coming soon, and don't forget that we'll be keeping you updated for 2022 with another Corgi Catalogue to come, featuring the products arriving in September to December. In addition, don't forget to check out the Die-Cast Diaries blog on **corgi.**co.uk, now running on a twice monthly update pattern to bring you the latest news on our product development. So far this year the blog has featured in-progress updates on our Supermarine Spitfire MkIX and Ford Cortina projects with exclusive first looks at early development samples, with first reveals of our other new tool products still to come!



The Aviation Archive range features high quality die-cast aircraft models produced in both 1:72 and 1:48 scales. Newly designed packaging styles highlight each model's place in real-world history, enabling collectors both new and old to easily identify areas of interest while expressing the sheer span and scope of the aviation world. Each aircraft comes with a display stand and many have optional parts enabling the model to be posed either in flight or stationary with the undercarriage down.

Work is now well underway on our 2022 new tool projects. Our two new Supermarine Spitfire models – the Spitfire MkIX, and the Spitfire T9 – are rapidly approaching the engineering sample stage, where we will see them 'in the metal' for the first time. In addition, our 1:48 scale Harrier GR5/7/9 project has been expanded to include AV-8B variants, allowing us to release liveries from the United States and other international operators. And not to forget our previously announced new tool of the Eurofighter FGR4, due to arrive in stock in the next few months!
