WELCOME TO THE SECOND CORGI® product announcement catalogue for 2025, revealing our brand-new releases due to arrive between May and August.

As you'll have seen from our front cover star, this edition sees the debut of our brand-new tool Ford Fiesta Mk2 in the Vanguards range. One of the most beloved vehicle models from Ford's catalogue, the Fiesta has incredibly only been represented in our collection by the Mk1.... until now. This fully featured tooling is designed to run and run, featuring multiple specifications of this modern classic with the incredible XR2 spec leading the new releases.

The Aviation Archive focuses on the 85th anniversary of the Battle of Britain in this release announcement, featuring two pairs of legendary fighter aircraft that faced off

against each other in the summer of 1940. Each tells a distinctive story that highlight the heroism and tragedy of this early defining battle of the Second World War.

We also have some big hitters in our entertainment licensed products, including the debut of the Aston Martin DB10 in our current James Bond collection! Marking the tenth anniversary of the release of Spectre, this bespoke Aston Martin continues to fill out the vehicles that featured during Daniel Craig's tenure as 007. Besides all of this, over the next few months we'll be attending both the Royal International Air Tattoo at RAF Fairford in July and DriveTribe Live at Bicester Heritage in August, so make sure to stay tuned to our social media and the Die-Cast Diaries blog on corgi.co.uk for some further surprise announcements to come!





To commemorate the Battle of Britain, we're releasing a special collection of paired fighters that fought over the summer of 1940, two from the Royal Air Force, and two from the Luftwaffe. Both the RAF fighters are in distinctive liveries, but also carry stories that highlight the heroism and tragedy of the conflict – Douglas Bader's Supermarine Spitfire MkI covers the legendary ace's first victory of the war, while Billy Fiske's Hawker Hurricane Mkl is a tribute to the first citizen American pilot to be killed in aerial combat in the Second World War. Meanwhile, the two German fighters reflect the perils of combat over foreign shores, with both aircraft forced down and captured by the British.

We also cover the later stages of the European air war with a pair of bombers that followed very different strategies. Following the many requests we've had for a B-17 Flying Fortress from the 100th Bomb Group of the USAAF 8th Air Force, we're thrilled to bring the B-17F back to the range for the first time in many years. Representing 'Royal Flush', the sole survivor of the mission that defined the unit and birthed the legend of 'The Bloody Hundredth', we couldn't think of a more fitting aircraft to represent the dangers of the daylight bombing doctrine of the American air force. The Royal Air Force followed a strategy of night bombing, represented here by the first Handley Page Halifax MkV in the range for eighteen years. 'London's Revenge' was an aircraft that was sponsored by MGM Studios, and as such carried a distinctive lion nose art into battle.
